##### Environmental | Elizabeth Link

- Update that the Lindley Pool located at the Lindley Rec Center will not be open for the 2025 Summer season and will likely not open until 2026.
- We discussed the future implementation of a Lindley Park Community Watch forum initiated by LPNA GPD Liaison, Charlie Brown. More details to come on this initiative.

- LPNA is working with the City's Traffic Management Program to ensure safe speed limits within the neighborhood as well as implementation of *traffic calming devices within the neighborhood*
  - *25 mph signs have been placed on Longview, Sherwood, Scott, Howard and Masonic/Cliffside establishing this speed limit vs 35 mph when unmarked. An electronic speed sensor will be rotated around these streets*
